

On Easter Sunday, Pastor Rusty will start a new sermons series "Been with Jesus" that examines some of the personal encounters that Jesus had with everyday people throughout the Gospels by looking at those who encountered Jesus on the day of his crucifixion.

We will not have adult or teen life groups on Easter Sunday.



### FROM THE PASTOR'S HEART

"In their fright, the women bowed down with their faces on the ground, but the men said to them, 'Why do you look for the living among the dead?' He is not here, He is Risen!"

Luke 24:5-6



I hope you will plan on joining us for our Holy week celebrations on both Sunday worship services on both Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday as we celebrate the death, burial and resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Even though we live in the shadow of the crucifixion, in a world filled with evil, pain, suffering and struggle, the promise of Easter Sunday and the resurrection reminds us of the hope we have in a secured eternity as we experience our own resurrections thanks to the redemption we can experiences through a relationship with our Savior. On Palm Sunday we will be following the example of Jesus on the last night he spent before his arrest with his closest followers by celebrating communion together. We will also have some special music from our worship choir and band along with music from our children's ministry. This will be a great way to prepare our hearts for Holy Week culminating in a special Easter worship service.

I will be kicking off a new sermon series Easter morning that will take us through the Summer entitled, "They

Have Been With Jesus" from the description of Peter and John given by the Jewish Leaders in Acts 4:13 "When they saw the courage of Peter and John and realized that they were unschooled, ordinary men, they were astonished and took note that these men had been with Jesus." This series will examine ordinary people who had an encounter with Jesus and how those encounters changed their lives. On Easter Sunday, we will look at several people who encountered Jesus on his path to the Cross and how those encounters changed their lives. Easter is a wonderful time to invite friends, families, neighbors and co-workers to join us for worship and I hope you will take some time for the Lord to put on your heart someone you can invite or bring with you for worship. It would be wonderful to have both worship services full on this special day.

This summer, I will celebrate my eighteenth year serving here as your Pastor and one of the things I have learned with that longevity is that staff transitions are a part of a growing church. As I reflected back on that time, I noted that we have been blessed with 5 different children's ministers, 3 student ministers, 4 worship Pastors and 3 office administrators. That includes how we have been incredibly blessed to have Sid Greene here leading our worship who will celebrate his 15<sup>th</sup> year as our worship Pastor in August. If we trust that God leads the right people here to serve our church, then we must trust that he also might lead them to another place of service or that the time may come where we need to part ways in the best interest of the church. Whatever the reason, transitions happen, and I choose to believe that as we find ourselves currently in a time of transition, this is a wonderful opportunity to position ourselves to continue to grow and move forward as a faith community as well as preparing us for an unlimited future in reaching the region for Christ.

We are currently taking applications for our Children's Minister position and we hope to have someone here by the summer. A wonderful thank you to all our volunteers for helping to fill in and even expand our children's ministry during this time of transition and as we continue

While we are searching to fill some spots, I am excited that we hope to fill one of our searches later this month. After a lengthy process, I am excited that we have a candidate coming the weekend of April 26<sup>th</sup>-27<sup>th</sup> for our Associate Pastor position. This candidate has met with both the personnel committee and deacon board, and both are recommending him to the church for a vote. I have spent a lot of time with him these last several months and I believe he is the perfect candidate and give him my highest recommendation. We will be telling you more about him, his family and ministry in the coming weeks and we will have a churchwide fellowship on Saturday evening, the 26<sup>th</sup> for anyone who can come, to be able to come and meet him and his wife in an informal setting. "Welcome to a new month and a brand-new truth: "I am set apart." This isn't just a catchy phrase—it's a powerful reminder of who God created you to be."






## WOMEN'S MINISTRY

#### JOB OPENING UPDATES

Associate Pastor – We are excited to announce that we will have a candidate for the Associate Pastor position here the weekend of April 27th . We will have a fellowship time with question and answers on Saturday, April 26th for anyone who would like to meet Him and his wife. He will be sharing and preaching in both worship services on Sunday, April 27th followed by a churchwide vote on the position. He is currently serving as a Lead Pastor with over 25 years of Pastor and Associate Pastor experience. He has met and interviewed with the Personnel Committee and Deacon Board, and both offer their recommendation that we hire him for this position. To be sensitive to the fact that he is currently serving as a Pastor at a Baptist Church in South Carolina, we will not be releasing all his personal information and job experience until Sunday, April 13th in the bulletin inserts. Please be in prayer for him and his family as he looks to follow God's will and join our staff and plan on being a part of this exciting weekend in the life of our church.

<u>Children's Ministry Position</u> – We are currently taking applications and resumes for our part time children's ministry job. This is a part-time position (12-15 hours a week) that is responsible for planning, organizing and overseeing all our weekly children's activities (nursery through 5th grade) as well as Vacation Bible School and other Children's events and volunteers. The pay scale is between \$23-30,000. depending on experience. Please help us get the word out to anyone you think might be interested and fit in well with our team and ministry. This is a full-time position that oversees all the main office responsibilities and acts as an administrator for our staff. A full job description is available in the church office.
